Dear Ms. Payne:

Enclosed with this letter to you, please find an Application for Reinstatement which I ask be filed on behalf of the above referenced corporation. Also included with this document is a check in the amount of \$458.75 which represents the Uniform Business Report filing fees for years 2002, 2003, and also the current year (2004) along with the \$8.75 fee required for a Certificate of Status on the current year.

To summarize the events leading to this situation, the corporation was originally incepted by Ms. Boswell during July, 2001. Shortly thereafter and during the planning process, Ms. Boswell abruptly relocated to the state of Georgia in search of more lucrative opportunities. We had a conversation during this time as she had expressed concerns as to whether or not her Florida corporation would be able to function in a different state, and I assured her that it would do fine, so long as all statutes and regulations for both states were followed and all filings were currently maintained. Due to personal and financial hardships she inevitably suffered while a resident there, the seemingly endless search for the more lucrative opportunities which never seemed to pan out, and other personal and business setbacks, she elected to re-locate back here to Florida, which she did during the latter stages of 2003.

Ms. Boswell and I lost contact during her time in Georgia as she had secured the services of a tax and accounting professional there who apparently knew absolutely nothing regarding Florida corporations, and as it turned out, corporations in general. With her complete trust in this person, he completely disregarded the fact that she had been operating as a corporation, thus there were no corporation tax returns filed on her behalf. It should also be noted that during this time there were no Uniform Business Reports received by her; I

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suspect that this was largely due to problems with the U.S. Post Office mail forwarding. In the event she had received such, I have no doubt that the Georgia tax professional would have advised her to simply disregard them.

She contacted me during the early stages of 2004 and we scheduled an appointment, at which time she advised me of this situation. I then conducted a complete review of what had taken place and immediately prepared corporation tax returns and amended individual tax returns for both states, some of which were delinquent, which have since been filed and processed. This was necessary to reflect the scope of business activity which had taken place since the inception of the corporation, not to mention the required compliance with current federal and state tax statutes. The next step is to bring the corporation current with the State of Florida. Therefore, it is asked that in light of these circumstances this corporation be reinstated, and also that any penalties be waived in this case.

In closing, kindly accept my appreciation for any efforts to bring this situation for Ms. Boswell to a current status, and in the event of questions or need for further information please do not hesitate to call upon me.
