THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION are hereby adopted by the undersigned incorporation of this corporation for pecuniary profit under the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE I NAME AND LOCATION OF AGENT AND OFFICES

- 1.1 Name. The name of the corporation shall be FAST CATS FERRY SERVICES, INC...
- 1.2 <u>Principal Office and Mailing Address</u>. The corporation's principal office, if known, shall be 215 8th Street East, Bradenton, Florida 34208, and the mailing address of the corporation shall be 215 8th Street East, Bradenton, Florida 34208. The corporation may change the foregoing addresses, transact business at other places within or without the State of Florida and establish branch offices within or without the State of Florida, all as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine.
