ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF TALLAHASSE TO STATE

INTERNATIONAL PRESENTATIONS CORP DRIDA

- 1. The following provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of INTERNATIONAL PRESENTATIONS CORP., a Florida corporation, filed with the Florida Department of State on August 3, 2001, are amended in the following particulars:
