ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MODERN AMERICAN GLOBAL INVESTORS CORPORATION

The undersigned, in order to form a corporation for the purpose hereinafter stated under and pursuant to the provision of chapter 607 of the FLORIDA STATUTES; hereby subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is MODERN AMERICAN GLOBAL INVESTORS CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II

The general and specific purpose for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell,
 assign, and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal
 with, goods, wares, and merchandise and real and personal property of every class
 and description.
- To engage in any commercial, industrial, and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the states in which business is transacted;

To generally engage in, do, and perform, any enterprises, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform; to engage in the manufacture, sale, purchase, importing, and exporting of merchandise and personal property of all manner and description, to act as gents for the purchase, sale, and handling of

- goods, wares, and merchandise of any and all types and descriptions for the account of the corporation or as factor, agent, procurer, or otherwise for or on behalf of another.
- 3. To manufacture, produce, purchase, or otherwise acquire, sell, or otherwise dispose of, import, export, distribute, deal in and with, whether as principal or agent, goods, wares, merchandise, and materials of every kind and description, whether now known or hereafter to be discovered or invented.
- 4. The purpose for which the corporation is formed are:
 - To engage primarily in the specific business of selling, buying,
 manufacturing, marketing, and distributing real and personal property of every
 kind and description.
 - To engage generally in the business of retail and wholesale selling,
 advertising, and marketing of services of every kind and description.
 - c. To engage in any business, related or unrelated to those described in clauses a and b of this Article, from time to time authorized or approved by the board of directors of this corporation or carry on any other trade or business which can, in the opinion of the board of directors of the company, be advantageously carried on in connection with or auxiliary to those described in clauses a and b of this Article, and to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.
 - d. To become a member of any partnership or joint venture and to enter into any lawful arrangement for sharing profits and/or losses in any transaction or transactions, and to promote and organize other corporations.

- e. To guarantee the contracts of customers and others.
- f. To do business anywhere in the world.
- g. To have and to exercise all rights and powers that are now or may hereafter be granted to a corporation by law.
- h. To acquire, hold, lease, encumber, convey, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property within or without the state, and take real and personal property by will, gift, or bequest.
- i. To assume any obligations, enter into any contracts, or do any acts incidental to the transaction of its business or to the issue or sale of its securities, or expedient for the attainment of its obligations by mortgage or otherwise.
- j. To borrow money and issue bonds, debentures, notes and evidences of indebtedness, and secure the payment of performance of its obligations by mortgage or otherwise.
- k. To acquire, subscribe for, hold, own, pledge, and otherwise dispose of and represent shares of stock, bonds, and securities of any other corporation, domestic or foreign.
- To purchase or otherwise acquire its own bonds, debentures, or other
 evidences of its indebtedness or obligation, and, subject to the provisions of
 the corporation laws of the state of incorporation, purchase or otherwise
 acquired its own shares.
- m. Subject to the provisions of these Articles, to redeem shares thereby made subject to redemption.

- n. To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific, or education purposes.
- o. To sue and be sued in any court.
- p. To adopt, use, and at will, alter a corporate seal, but failure to affix a seal shall not affect the validity of any instrument.
- q. To make bylaws.
- r. To appoint such subordinate officers or agents as its business may require, and to allow them suitable compensation.

The foregoing shall be construed as objects, purposes, and powers, and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers now or hereafter conferred on this corporation by the laws of the state of incorporation or any state within which business may be carried on.

The objects, purposes, and powers specified herein shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any purposes, and powers specified in each of the clauses or paragraphs of these Articles of Incorporation shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes, or powers.

The corporation may in its bylaws confer powers, not in conflict with law, upon its directors in addition to the foregoing and in addition to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon them by statute.

Agency and Business Promotion

To transact the business of advertising, promoting, and developing the business of other corporations, partnerships, or individuals for hire, or upon commission, or otherwise, by and through the means of preparing advertising for other corporations, partnerships, or individuals, and of advertising the business, commodities, or other property, real, personal, or mixed, of other corporations, partnerships, or individuals in newspapers, books, booklets, prospectuses, magazines, circulars, pamphlets, or other similar literature and advertising media.

Art and Artists Supplies Dealer

To carry on the business of holders of exhibitions and dealers in pictures, and makers and sellers of picture frames, artists' colors, oils, paints, paint brushes, and other instruments, articles, and ingredients relating to any such business.

Bookstore

To conduct and carry on in all of its branches and business of buying, selling, and dealing in and with books of any and all kinds, whether new or old, and manuscripts, prints, engravings, lithographs, pamphlets, writing, publications, stationery, and similar goods or merchandise; to conduct the business of an agency in all of its branches for any and all of the goods or merchandise; to acquire and carry on a selling agency or agencies for the sale of any and all merchandise pertaining or relating to books, manuscripts, prints, engravings, lithographs, pamphlets, writings, and similar goods or merchandise; to deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise and personal property of every and any sort, nature, or description.

Farm Ownership and Farming

To purchase, own, improve, equip, operate, and manage farms and engage in any agricultural pursuit or undertaking.

Furniture Manufacture

To engage in the business of manufacturing wood and metal home and office furniture, cabinets, and other items, including their component parts and materials, of every nature and description.

Groceries

To merchandise, sell, offer for sale, and distribute at wholesale and retail, foods and foodstuffs of all kinds and descriptions, whether in bulk, package, bottle, or can, including beverages of all kinds and for all purposes, and to generally deal in groceries and grocery products suitable for public consumption.

Hardware Store

To engage in and operate a general hardware and mercantile business and to deal in, buy, and sell general hardware, electrical and gas appliances, housewares, toys, general merchandise including paints and painting supplies, but not excluding any other articles of merchandise sometimes dealt in by hardware establishments.

Marketing

To enter into contracts or agreements relating to sales campaigns and marketing and to the design, manufacture, operation, and use of tools and tooling of every kind, character, and description, including, without being limited to, mechanical, pneumatic, hydraulic, electrical, or artistic devices, articles, or designs with any and all persons, firms, corporations, or other legal entity, whether domestic or foreign.

Retail Stores

To establish, purchase, lease, as lessee, or otherwise acquire, to own, operate, and maintain, and to sell mortgage, lease as lessor, and otherwise dispose of retail stores or departments therein and to conduct a general merchandising business therein.

To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers enumerated in these Articles of Incorporation and benefit of the corporation, as principal agent, director, trustee or otherwise; and, in general either alone or in association with other corporations, forms, or individuals; to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of the purpose or the attainment of the objects; or the furtherance of such purposes or objects of the corporation; whether or not such business is similar in nature to the purposes and objects as set forth in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment hereof.

ARTICLE III

The amount of capital stock with which the corporation shall begin business shall be 100,000 shares of common stock, \$1.00 par value.

Such stock may be issued by the Board of Directors; and such consideration as in the opinion of the Board of Directors is equivalent to the par value thereof; and said stock may be paid for in money; property; labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors or issued as partly paid when so ordered by the Board of Directors; and any and all such shares; so issued; shall be deemed fully paid stock; and not liable to any further call or assessment thereon, and the holder of such shares shall not be liable for any further payment thereon.

ARTICLE IV

The amount of capital with which the corporation shall begin business shall not be less than \$500.00.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI
