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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF HISTORIC CHIPLEY ANTIQUE MALL, INC.



Section I

The name of this corporation shall be **HISTORIC CHIPLEY ANTIQUE MALL**, **INC.**

Section II

The purpose of the business is to engage in any activities or businesses permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida. Further, to enter into any arrangement with any governmental authorities, local, state or national, or any person, firm or corporation that may seem conducive to the corporation's object, or any of them, and to obtain from such governmental authorities, persons, firms or corporations such rights, privileges, franchises or concession which the corporation may deem desirable to obtain, and which may seem conducive to the objects of the corporation; generally, to undertake and transact any business of capitalists, financial agents, manufacturers' representatives, trustees or promoters, which may seem conducive to any of the objects of the corporation; and to exercise any and all of the powers of corporations as authorized by Section 607, of the Florida Statutes.

Section III

Common Stock - That the maximum number of shares of common capital stock, non-cumulative, which the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time

is one thousand (1,000) shares with a par value of \$1.00 per share, with the right to increase the number of outstanding shares as provided by the Laws of the State of Florida.

Section IV

The amount of capital which the corporation shall begin business is \$500.00.

Section V

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

Section VI

The principal office of the corporation shall be 1368 North Railroad Avenue, Chipley, Florida, 32428.

Section VII

The Board of Directors shall be composed of no less than two (2) members.


