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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MOBILE LUBE TECHS, INC

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person, competent to contract, hereby forms a Corporation under the laws tate of Florida.

ARTICLE I.

<u>NAME</u>

The name of the Corporation shall be: MOBILE LUBE TECHS, INC.

ARTICLE II.

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this Corporation shall be: 1010 S.W. 87th Court, Miami, Florida 33174.

ARTICLE III.

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is formed and the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

- a) To transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act.
 - b) To do such other things as are incidental, necessary or desirable in order

to accomplish the foregoing.

ARTICLE IV.

CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares that this corporation is to have outstanding at any one time is Five Hundred (500) shares of common stock, having a nominal or par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be fixed by the board of directors but in no event shall be less that \$1.00

ARTICLE V.

TERM

This corporation shall commence existence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation and shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI.

REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED OFFICE

The Registered Agent for this corporation shall be: Richard Hervis, Jr., 1010 S.W. 87th Court, Miami, Florida 33174 or at such other place as the Board of Directors shall from time to time direct, with appropriate notice being given to the Secretary of State in accordance with the law.

The aforementioned location constitutes the principal office.

ARTICLE VII.

DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have not less than one nor more than three directors, as set forth in the By-Laws. The names and street addresses of the first board of directors of this corporation which, subject to these Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws of this corporation, and the Laws of the State of Florida, shall hold office until its successors have been elected and qualified, are:

INSPECTION OF BOOKS AND RECORDS

The corporation shall from time to time determine whether and to what extent and at what times and places and under what conditions and regulations the accounts and books of the corporation (other than the stock book) or any of them shall be open to inspection of shareholders; and no shareholder shall have the right of inspecting any accounts, book or document of this corporation except as conferred by statute, unless authorized by a resolution of the shareholders or the board of directors.

ARTICLE X.
