ARTICLE I - Name

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the fullest extent permitted by law.


ARTICLE X - Initial Registered Office and Agent





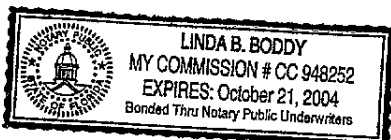
