The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is: A-CLASS AUTO SALES OF CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC., whose initial business address is 5250 S. U.S. Hwy. 17-92, Suite No. 4, Casselberry, FL 32707.

Article 2. Duration The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. Purpose. The general purposes for which the Corporation is organized are the following:

- A. To engage in and transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act. No other purpose limits this general purpose in any way.
- B. To do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the Corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.
- C. To engage in the business of buying, selling, or dealing in motor vehicles or offering or displaying motor vehicles for sale at wholesale or retail; together with all ancillary services and products, including lease-purchase transactions.

Article 6. Initial Board of Directors. The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is one (1). Article 10. Rights of Initial Directors. Corporation. This Article may not be amended in any way without the written consent of each of the initial Directors who is a Shareholder of the Corporation at the time of the amendment.

Article 11. Bylaws. The power to adopt, alter, amend and repeal the Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors, but all alterations, amendments and repeals of the Bylaws must be approved by a majority of the Shareholders.

Article 12. Commencement of Corporate Existence. In accordance with Section 607.l67, Florida Statutes, the date when corporate existence shall commence is the date of subscription and acknowledgment of these Articles of Incorporation.
