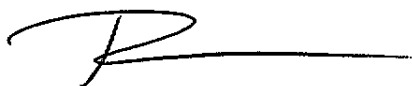

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of this corporation pursuant to Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby forms a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation

ARTICLE I - NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation shall be DIVERSIFIED INDEPENDENT VENTURE ANALYSTS, INC.

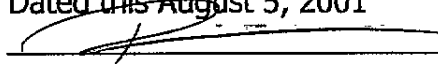

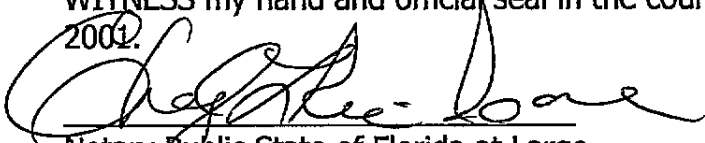
