ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned Incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, being duly licensed to practice dentistry medicine and orthodontic care and treatment under the laws of the State of Florida, adopt(s) these Articles to form a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 621, and other laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the professional service corporation is DRS. CHASOLEN & CHASOLEN, P.A.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE VIII - RESTRAINT ON ALIENATION OF SHARES

The Shareholders of the professional service corporation shall have the power to include in the Bylaws, or by separate agreement adopted by a majority of the Shareholders of the professional service corporation, any regulatory or restrictive provisions regarding the proposed sale, transfer, or other disposition of any of the outstanding stock of the professional service corporation by any of its Shareholders, or in the event of the death of any of its Shareholders. The professional service corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner provided by law. Any right conferred on the Shareholders is subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE X - INDEMNIFICATION

The professional service corporation shall indemnify each of the Officers, Directors, employees and agents to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law.
