ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WESTON TUTORING, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be WESTON TUTORING, INC.

ARTICLE II
