ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MERCURY INDEMNITY COMPANY OF FLORIDA



Pursuant to the provisions of Section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida profit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

FIRST: Amendment adopted:

ARTICLE III CAPITAL STOCK
