ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The initial street address of the Corporation's registered office is 222 S. Pennsylvania Avenue, Suite 200, Winter Park, Florida 32789, and the initial registered agent at such address is Robert P. Saltsman. The board of directors from time to time may move the registered office of the Corporation to any other address in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There shall be a board of directors for this Corporation that shall consist of not less than one (1). Except for the number constituting the initial board of directors, the number of directors shall be decided by the resolution of the shareholders. ARTICLE X

PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Any amendment of these Articles of Incorporation so made must be approved by a majority vote of the shareholders of the Corporation.
