

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PAPERWORKS, INC.



PAPERWORKS, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), by and through its President, hereby adopts an amendment to its Articles of Incorporation as hereinafter set forth.

1. Pursuant to Section 607.1003 of the Florida Statutes, the Board of Directors of the Corporation and the sole shareholder of the Corporation adopted, in accordance with Sections 607.0821 and 607.0704 of the Florida Statutes, on September (2001), an amendment to Article II of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, deleting Article II in its entirety and substituting therefor the following:

ARTICLE II -Principal Office

The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation is 706 Savage Court, Longwood, Florida 32750.

- 2. Except as modified hereby, the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation shall be and remain in full force and effect.
- 3. The number of votes cast for the amendment by the shareholders was sufficient for approval, and the Corporation's shareholders are not divided into different voting groups.
