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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

INFORMATION SOLUTIONS, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

Section 1.1 <u>Name</u>. The name of the corporation is Information Solutions, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

Section 2.1 <u>Duration</u>. This corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporation existence shall commence on the date these Articles are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five days, exclusive of legal holidays, after they are executed and acknowledged, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

Section 3.1 <u>Purpose</u>. This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

Section 4.1 <u>Authorized Capital</u>. The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 500 shares of voting Common Stock having a par value of \$1 per share.

Section 4.2 <u>Restrictions on Transfer of Stock</u>. The shareholders may, by agreement or bylaw provision, impose such restrictions on the sale, transfer, or encumbrance of the stock of this corporation as is deemed necessary.

Section 4.3 <u>Approval of Shareholders Required for Merger</u>. The approval of a majority of the holders of Common Stock of this corporation to any plan of merger or consolidation shall be required in every case, whether or not such approval is required by law.

ARTICLE V - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

Section 5.1 <u>Name and Address</u>.
