

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

for

Palm Beach Special Needs Transportation, Inc.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. Name: The name of the corporation is Palm Beach Special Needs Transportation, Inc. The address of the corporate office shall be 5771 Fairway Park Court, Building #17-202, Boynton Beach, Florida 33437.

ARTICLE II. Duration: The period of this corporation's duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III. Purpose: The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida, including transportation services for special needs individuals and related activities, within and without the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. Capital Stock: The corporation is authorized to issue 100 shares, all of one class, at no par value.
