FINAL JUDGMENT ON PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE heard before Judge Nancy Moate Ley on August 26, 2005 on the Wife's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and the Husband's Answer to Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Counter-Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, the Wife having appeared with counsel and the Husband having been given proper notice of hearing, the Court having heard the testimony of the Wife, reviewed the Court file and the parties' Mediation Agreement and being otherwise fully advised on the premises, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

1. That the Wife has been a permanent, continuous resident of the State of Florida for at least six (6) months before the filing of the Petition for Dissolution.
2. That the parties were married on June 2, 2001 in Pinellas County, Florida.
3. That there are no minor children born or adopted of the marriage and the Wife is not now pregnant.
4. That the marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken.
5. That the parties have freely and voluntarily entered into a Mediation Agreement

That the Mediation Agreement entered into between the parties and introduced into evidence is in the best interests of the parties and is therefore approved, ratified, and incorporated by reference into this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage, and the parties are ordered to comply with it.
