**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**OF**  
**CITIZENS FOR ENDURING COMMUNITIES, INC.**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of this Corporation pursuant to Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, adopts the following articles of incorporation as follows:

**I.**  
**NAME**

The name of this Corporation is CITIZENS FOR ENDURING COMMUNITIES, INC. The initial address of the corporation is

Southport, Florida 32409

**II.**  
**DURATION**

The period of the duration of this Corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law. Corporate existence shall commence upon filing with the Secretary of State.

**III.**  
**PURPOSE**

The purposes for which this Corporation is created and maintained shall be:

- (1) To gather, analyze and disseminate data and information relating to issues of the Panama City - Bay County airport location and relocation and their impact on communities' service, the environment and taxation.
- (2) To serve as a core organization to bring together representatives of various organizations which have the common goal of preserving the environment, commercial and general aviation air services to the communities served, and tax funds.
- (3) To conduct fund raising activities for the production of revenues adequate to carry out the purposes of the Corporation.
- (4) To disseminate to the public, civic organizations, and other entities information relating to the issues identified above.

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

- (5) To do any other lawful acts and to conduct all other lawful business purposes as are allowed under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.

**IV.**  
**MEMBERS**

The members of the Corporation shall be the Board of Directors appointed by the incorporator and such other persons as may be selected in accordance with the By-laws. The By-laws shall describe the rights of members.

**BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS**

The number of persons constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be no less than one nor more than six. Directors shall be elected or appointed, or serve ex-officio in accordance with the By-laws of the Corporation. The By-laws may also provide for the selection of such officers as are deemed necessary or desirable.

**VII.**  
**INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS**

All officers and directors of this Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including attorney's fees (including appellate proceedings), reasonably incurred in connection with any proceeding or settlement thereof in which they may become involved by reason of holding such office as provided in the By-laws. The Corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of all officers and directors against any liability asserted against them or incurred by them in their capacity as officers and directors or arising out of their status as such.

This Corporation is organized on a stock basis with 100 shares of one dollar par value stock.

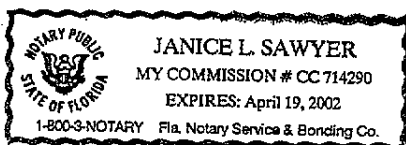
