

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF



SILVER STAR LEARNING CENTER, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

SILVER STAR LEARNING CENTER, INC

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The corporation may engage in all lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida, or any other state, country, territory or nation.

The activities may include but not be limited to child care industry and any other activities related to child care business.

To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit as to amount and with any person, firm, association or corporation; to draw make accept endorse, discount, issue, and execute promissory notes, warrants, and other negotiable or transferable interests.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, to own, hold, use, enjoy, sell, assign and transfer, exchange or otherwise dispose of, deal in, or deal with personal property of every kind and description without limit as to the amount thereof and wherever the same may be situated.

To borrow and to loan money, to give and to receive evidence of indebtedness and security therefore: to draw, make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes,

every kind and secure any or all obligations of the corporation by mortgage and deed or otherwise.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time shall be as follows: Five Thousand (5,000) shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be as fixed by the board of directors, and may take the form of services rendered, cash, property, or any other from deem satisfactory by the board of directors.

ARTICLE IV. INITIAL CAPITAL

The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business shall not be less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
