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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation shall be:

MAID-TO -CLEAN SERVICES OF TAMPA, INC.

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF BUSINESS

THE GENERAL NATURE OF THE BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED BY THIS CORPORATION is to purchase or otherwise acquire, to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services in every class, kind and description; except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety association, fraternal benefit society, state fair or exposition.

- (2) to contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfer of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required;
- (3) to purchase the corporate assets in any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business:
- (4) to guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidence of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock:
- (5) to engage in any and all other activity or business whatever permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 100 shares of common stock of a par value of \$1.00 per share.
