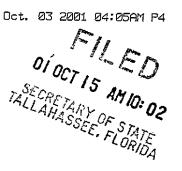

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COTON, LAVIGNE & ASSOCIATES, P.A.



The undersigned all of whom are duly licensed to practice law in the State of Florida. desiring to form a professional corporation in accordance with Chapter 607 of the FL Statues and the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

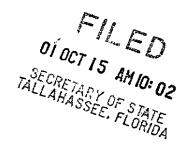
