ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COLLEGE CLUB MANAGEMENT, INC.

ASSERVENCE, 20 The undersigned hereby files these Articles of Incorporation of College Club Man Inc., a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I Name and Principal Office

The name of this Corporation shall be COLLEGE CLUB MANAGEMENT, INC. The principal place of business and mailing address of this Corporation shall be 384 South Franklin Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32301.

ARTICLE II **Purpose and Nature of Business**

The sole purpose for which the Corporation is formed is to acquire a membership interest in College Club Apartments at Tallahassee, L.L.C., a Florida limited liability company (the "LLC"), to serve as the LLC's Managing Member, and to engage in such other lawful activities permitted to corporations under the laws of the State of Florida as are incidental, necessary, or appropriate to accomplish the foregoing purpose.

ARTICLE III Stock

The authorized capital stock of this Corporation shall consist of 10,000 shares of Common Stock with a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share. The stock of the Corporation shall be issued for such consideration as may be determined by the Board of Directors but not less than par value.

ARTICLE IV Powers

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation and any provision of law that so empowers the Corporation, as long as the Amended and Restated Mortgage, Assignment of Leases and Rents, Security Agreement and Fixture Filing (the "Mortgage"), that the LLC intends to execute and deliver to General Electric Capital Corporation (the "Lender"), which Mortgage shall encumber the LLC's property in Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida, and located at 2833 South Adams Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32304 and commonly known as College Club Apartments at Tallahassee (the "Property"), remains outstanding, the Corporation shall not, without the unanimous consent of its Board of Directors, do any of the following:

engage in any business or activity other than the business described in Article II (i) hereof and activities incidental thereto, or cause or allow the LLC to engage in any

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- business or activity other than as set forth in its Amended and Restated Articles of Organization;
- (ii) incur any indebtedness other than the Mortgage and the indebtedness permitted thereunder and normal trade accounts payable in the ordinary course of business, or assume or guaranty any indebtedness of any other entity;
- (iii) cause the LLC to incur any indebtedness or to assume or guaranty any indebtedness of any other entity, other than the Mortgage, any indebtedness permitted thereunder, and normal trade accounts payable in the ordinary course of the LLC's business:
- (iv) dissolve or liquidate, in whole or in part;
- (v) cause or consent to the dissolution or liquidation, in whole or in part, of the LLC;
- (vi) consolidate or merge with or into any other entity or convey or transfer or lease its property and assets substantially as an entirety to any entity;
- (vii) cause the LLC to consolidate or merge with or into any other entity or to convey or transfer or lease its Property and assets substantially as an entirety to any entity;
- (viii) with respect to the Corporation or the LLC, institute proceedings to be adjudicated bankrupt or insolvent, or consent to the institution or bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings against it, or file a petition seeking or consenting to reorganization or relief under any applicable federal or state law relating to bankruptcy, or consent to the appointment of a receiver, liquidator, assignee, trustee, sequestrator (or other similar official) of the Corporation or the LLC or a substantial part of property of the Corporation or the LLC, or make any assignment for the benefit of creditors, or admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or take corporate action in furtherance of any such action;
- (ix) withdraw as a member of the LLC;
- (x) amend or modify Articles II, IV or VIII of these Articles of Incorporation; or
- (xi) in addition to the foregoing, so long as any obligation secured by the Mortgage remains outstanding and not discharged in full, the Corporation shall not, without the written consent of the holder of the Mortgage, take any action set forth in items (i) through (vii) and items (ix) and (x).

ARTICLE V Incorporator

ARTICLE VI Term of Corporate Existence

This Corporation shall exist perpetually or until it is dissolved according to the provisions of Florida law.

- (iii) hold regular Board of Director and stockholder meetings, as appropriate, to conduct the business of the Corporation, and observe all other corporate formalities;
- (iv) hold itself out to creditors and the public as a legal entity separate and distinct from any other entity;
- (v) prepare separate tax returns and financial statements, or if part of a consolidated group, then it will be shown as a separate member of such group;

- (vi) allocate and charge fairly and reasonably any common employee or overhead shared with affiliates:
- (vii) transact all business with affiliates on an arm's-length basis and pursuant to enforceable agreements;
- (viii) conduct business in its own name, and use separate stationery, invoices and checks;
- (ix) not commingle its assets or funds with those of any other person; and
- (x) not assume, guarantee or pay the debts or obligations of any other person.
