

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

RJM CARPETS, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation is RJM Carpets, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation is:

ARTICLE III CAPITAL STOCK



The number of shares of stock that the Corporation is authorized to issue is Ten Thousand (10,000) shares, \$.01 par value per share, of common stock. Each issued and outstanding share of common stock shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at a meeting of the shareholders.

ARTICLE IV INITIAL DIRECTORS

The initial directors of the Corporation shall be appointed by the Incorporator. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the Bylaws but shall never be less than one (1).

ARTICLE V INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE VI INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE VII INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify any present or former officer or director, or person exercising powers and duties of an officer or a director, to the full extent now or hereafter permitted by law.
