ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ELEGANCE DELIVERANCE LIMO, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is ELEGANCE DELIVENCE LIMO, Inc.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation is organized for the purpose of LIMOUSINE SERVICE AND TRANSPORTATIONS and Doing business permitted under the laws of United States and the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - AUTHORIZED SHARES

The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 7,500 shares of capital stock for the par value of \$0.01 per share, The sum of \$75.00, the par value of all of capital stock for the corporation that have been issued, shall be the stated capital of the corporation at any particular time. The holders of the outstanding capital stock shall be entitled to receive, when and as declared by the Board of Director, dividends payable either in cash, in property, or in shares of the capital stock of the corporation. The shares of the corporation are not to be divided into classes, and the corporation is not authorized to issue shares in series.

ARTICLE V - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE VI - DIRECTORS

The initial Board of Director shall consist of two (2) members who need not be a resident of the State of Florida or a shareholder of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII - INITIAL DIRECTORS

The names and addresses of persons who shall serve as Directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders, or until their successors shall have elected and qualified, are as follows:

ARTICLE IX - PREEMPTIVE RIGHT

The holders of the common stock of this corporation shall have preemptive rights to purchase, at prices, terms and conditions that shall be fixed by the Board of Directors, such shares of the stock of this corporation as may be issued for money, or any property or service from time to time, in addition to stock authorized and issued by corporation. The preemptive

right of any holder is determined by a ratio of the authorized and issued shares of common stock held by the holder of all shares of common stock currently and issued.

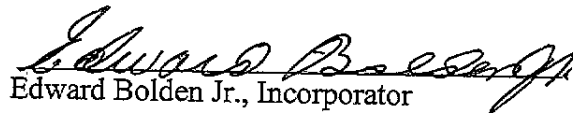
ARTICLE X - CUMULATIVE VOTE

Notice must be given by any shareholder to the president or a Vice-President of said corporation not less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time set for the holding of a shareholder's meeting for the election of directors that said shareholder intends to cumulate his vote at said election.

ARTICLE XI - SECTION 1244

This corporation and the shareholders hereof shall be Section 1244 of the United States Internal Revenue Code.

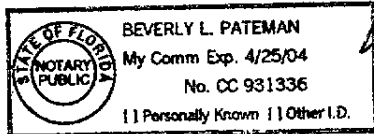
