Dear Florida Division of Corporations,

I am responding to the Notice of Administrative Dissolution sent to the Mattress Doctor, Inc. We have included payment in full for the 2002 Uniform Business Report. We are requesting that the reinstatement fee be waived the dissolution notice is the first and only notice received. We have had a number of problems the 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2002 with our mail since the previous business, was the Mattress Firm. We have received their mail as well as mail addressed to us has been forwarded to their Houston corporate offices. We have been using a Post office box and alternate address for most of our mail. Unfortunately, the address registered on the articles of incorporation was 2523 East Colonial was established before this problem was discovered and we only discovered once the mail snafu was resolved.

We are small start-up and only have been in business since January of this year. Normally, this would require our 1<sup>st</sup> Uniform Business Report to be filed in 2003. After, reviewing the articles of incorporation I now understand part of the problem also was that our date of incorporation was at the end of December rather than the beginning of January when we began our retail operation. If reinstatement fee is not waived, we proposed amending the date of incorporation to January 1<sup>st</sup> 2003. This would also resolve the issue. Since a UBR would not be required for 2002. If this is the best option, please call me so I may pay the fee by phone or via sunbiz.org to amend our articles of incorporation.

Our actions were not a willful neglect of the law. Your understanding in waiving the fee for our first and only late payment will help our business in its infancy, utilizing crucial funds that will serve to grow and ensure the future prosperity of our business. It is our desire to be a successful business in the State Of Florida for many years to come, and our success will also means a steady stream of revenue for the State. Therefore, waiver of the Mattress Doctor's reinstatement fee serves; both the State of Florida's and ours.
