### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# 010EC17 ED MILLENNIUM PROPERTIES OF SARASOTA COUNTY

The undersigned subscriber these Articles to Incorporation does hereby form a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, Chapter 607, Florida Statutes.

### ARTICLE I

### NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation shall be MILLENNIUM PROPERTIES OF SARASOTA, INC.

### ARTICLE II

### GENERAL NATURE

The general nature of the activities Corporation shall be the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under this Chapter 607 Florida Statutes.

### ARTICLE III

### CAPITAL STOCK

- A. The maximum number of shares of capital stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is One Hundred Thousand Shares (100,000) of Common Stock having a par value of One Dollar (1.00) per share, which shall be without preemptive rights.
