ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

Sugar Enterprises, Inc.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is Sugar Enterprises Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The Corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing on the date of January 1, 2002 filing these Articles with the Department of State.
