ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

RBH Service Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, in accordance with Section 607.0202, Florida Statutes, 2001, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

The name of the corporation shall be RBH Service Corporation and the initial principal office shall be at 111 Second Avenue, N.E., in the City of St. Petersburg, County of Pinellas, State of Florida.

Article II

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

Article III

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be: To engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida and to carry out said purposes in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any foreign country, to the extent that these purposes are not forbidden by the law of the state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or by the foreign country.

Article IV

The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall consist of 10,000 shares (when fully issued) of \$2.00 par value common stock.

Article V

The business and affairs of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Directors, all as more fully set forth in the by-laws of the corporation.

Article VI

The names and addresses of the individuals who will serve as initial Directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders, or until their successors shall have been elected and qualified are as follows:
