Dear Department of State,

I am writing this letter to address a serious situation on the behalf of my corporation. I have recently (today Oct 23, 2003) discovered a situation that is beyond my control. I have no recourse other than to "attempt with full honesty and earnest effort to correct the situation". I am asking for an abatement of traditional penalties and interest in this extreme case. I have been incorporated since 1/4/02 and have to the best of my ability complied with the Florida and Federal filing requirements. I have successfully filed payroll tax reports, corporate tax returns and annual reports since the inception of my business. I have without fail tried to my best ability to comply with all rules and regulations.

The purpose of this letter to explain this unfortunate situation and plead for some sort of understanding and fairness. Here we go:

In early 2002, I incorporated my business. I properly filed the incorporation papers and other filings. My inexperience in these matters left me overwhelmed with the filign requirements. I never received the first or second UNIFORM BUSINESS REPORTS.

It came to my attention on Oct 23, 2003 when I went to renew some of my business contracts with a vendor. The vendor made me aware of that my corporation had been "ADMIN DISSOLUTION FOR ANNUAL REPORT". As soon as I realized this, I researched the issue. I researched my account history on the website after speaking with someone at the Division of Corporations. I soon discovered I never received the annual reports. I am writing to ask for some understanding on this issue given my filing history, earnest attempt to correct the situation and honesty. I am writing to request a fair resolution to this error. I would have filed these forms if I would have received them in the mail properly. I understand the filing requirements now and promise to comply with them in the future.

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I am sending in the annual report along with a check for tax years 2003. I am a small business owner who has made a mistake via the mail system. Please accept these payments and re-instatement my corporation. This situation has caused me great stress and worry. I am working hard every single day just to survive and make it in the business world. Please give me an opportunity to resolve this issue fairly and move on. I respect your understanding in this unforeseen incident.
