ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AVENUES INTERIORS & ACCESSORIES, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I Name

Section 1.1. <u>Name</u>. The name of this corporation is AVENUES INTERIORS & ACCESSORIES, INC. and the address is 11035 Phillips Highway, Suite 2, Jacksonville, Florida 32256.

ARTICLE II <u>Duration</u>

Section 2.1. <u>Duration</u>. This corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five days, exclusive of legal holidays, after they are executed and acknowledged, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III <u>Purpose</u>

Section 3.1. <u>Purposes</u>. This corporation is organized for the sole and specific purpose of operating a retail home furnishings store. Section 6.1. <u>Number</u>. This corporation shall have two (2) directors initially.
