# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GREGORY C. HUBNER, CPA, P.A.

The undersigned incorporator hereby executes and acknowledges these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

# **Business and Purposes**

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation, or the objects or purposes of the corporation, shall be as follows:

- (a) to engage solely and specifically in the business of carrying on the general practice of public accounting, including, but not limited to, tax compliance and consulting services, as a certified public accountant.
- (b) to invest in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investments;
