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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
DRY CLEAN INNOVATIONS, INC.**

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be **DRY CLEAN INNOVATIONS, INC.**

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES, POWERS, & RIGHTS

This corporation is being organized for the purpose of engaging in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the laws of the State of Florida.
