**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

I, the undersigned, do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge, and file these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of incorporating CENTER FOR THE STUDY OF SENIOR STRESS, INC. (the "Corporation"), under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

NAME - The name of the Corporation is: CENTER FOR THE STUDY OF SENIOR STRESS, INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS - The Corporation's principal office shall be located at 3206 East Lakeshore Drive, Tallahassee, Florida 32312 and its mailing address shall be P.O. Box 15682, Tallahassee, Florida 32317.

ARTICLE III

TERM OF EXISTENCE - This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.

INDEMNIFICATION- The Board of Directors is authorized, to the extent allowable by law, to indemnify any officers, directors, employees, or other agents of the Corporation for any liability arising out of an act performed in furtherance of the officers', directors', employees', or agents' duties to the Corporation.
