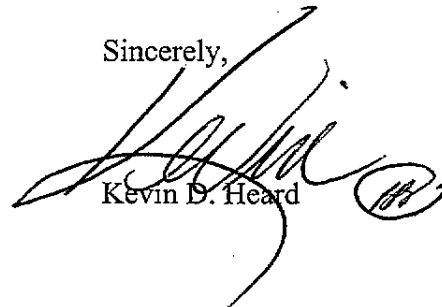

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOUND SEARCH INC.

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

I, Robert W. Langford, the undersigned, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to Chapters 607 and 621, Florida Statutes, hereby certifies and makes these Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be Sound Search, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Period of Duration

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

The corporation shall have the following purposes:

- A. To transact any and all lawful businesses for which corporations may be organized under and by virtue of Chapter 607 and Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, et sequitur.
- 2. To engage in the management and ownership of a personnel firm.
- C. To do such other things as are incidental, proper or necessary to the operation of the business, or to the carrying out of the objects, purposes, powers and privileges herein granted, as well as to conduct any business or activity which may be legally and properly conducted by business corporations and enumerated in the Florida Corporation Act, as amended, together with all other rights bestowed upon such corporations under the laws of the State of Florida.
