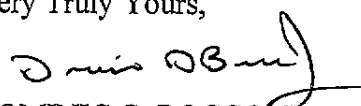

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

A PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION OF DOMINIC G. BOCCO, JR., P.A.

THE UNDERSIGNED natural person, competent and licensed to practice law in the State of Florida, acting hereby as incorporator of the purpose of forming a Professional Service Corporation for profit under the provisions of Section 607, Florida General Corporation Act, and Section 621, Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, of the Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this professional association shall be:

DOMINIC G. BOCCO, JR., P.A.

ARTICLE II

The general nature and purposes of the business to be transacted, promoted and carried on by the professional association are as follows:

- a. To engage in every aspect of the practice of law and the provision of legal services and all its fields of specialization, as are engaged in by **DOMINIC G. BOCCO, JR., P.A.** and any associates, assistants or para-professionals hired by them.
- b. To engage and render the professional services involved only through its officers, agents and employees who shall be accountants, para-professionals, assistants and other individuals in good standing and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional services as this professional association.
- c. To invest in funds, real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds and any other type of investments permitted by law.
- d. To engage in no other business, other than the rendition of the professional services specified herein.

- e. To do everything necessary and proper in accomplishing the purposes herein set forth and to do anything incidental thereto which is not forbidden under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

Any action of the shareholder(s) may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all shareholders entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the secretary of the professional association as part of the corporate records.

If any officer, director, stockholder, agent or employee of this professional association becomes legally disqualified to render the professional services for which the professional association is organized, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on his/her continued rendering of such professional services, he/she shall forthwith sever all employment with the professional association, upon disqualification of any shareholder, purchase such shareholder's share and pay him/her all amounts owing and lawfully due to him/her by the professional association, except that such shares shall not be entitled to dividends.

ARTICLE X

If all of the Directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the professional association, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with, be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.

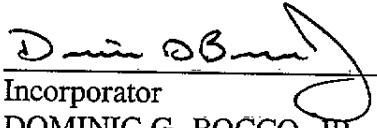
ARTICLE XI

ARTICLE XII

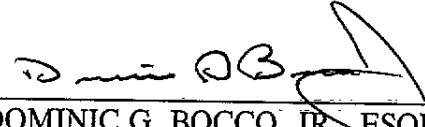
