

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
ED OVERSTREET INSURANCE, INC.**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation for profit under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

**ARTICLE I.**

**NAME:** The name of this corporation is **ED OVERSTREET INSURANCE, INC.** and the principal place of business shall be at 887 South Ferdon Boulevard, Crestview, Florida 32536.

**ARTICLE II.**

**DURATION:** The corporation shall exist perpetually.

**ARTICLE III.**


