ARTICLE VII INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify any Officer or Director or any former Officer or Director, to the full extent permitted by law. The rights of indemnification provided in this Article shall be in addition to any rights to which any such director, officer, employee or agent may otherwise be entitled by contract or as a matter of law. The intent of the incorporators, with respect to indemnification, may be further explained in terms consistent with this Article in the bylaws, pursuant to Article VIII.

Notwithstanding any provision or statement in this Article to the contrary, no indemnification or advancement of expenses shall be made to or on behalf of any director officer employee or agent if a judgment or other final adjudication establishes that his actions, or omissions to act, were material to the cause of action so adjudicated and constitute:

- 1) a violation of criminal law, unless the director, officer, employee or agent had reasonable cause to believe his conduct was lawful or had no reasonable cause to believe his conduct was unlawful
- 2) a transaction from which the director, officer, employee or agent derived an improper personal benefit
- 3) in the case of a director, a circumstance under which the liability provisions of Fl. Stat. 607.0834, as presently and hereafter enacted, are applicable or
- 4) willful misfeasance, bad faith or gross negligence in the performance of any directors officers employees or agents duties, or constitute reckless disregard of such directors, officers employees or agents obligations and duties to the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX
BYLAWS

The Board of Directors and the shareholders shall each have the power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal Bylaws.

CORPORATE EXISTENCE


The existence of this Corporation shall be perpetual and shall commence on the date of acknowledgement and subscription of these Articles.




