That pursuant to the provisions of section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, this corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

Be it amended that the original Article of Incorporation have been changed to délete Eugenio Mader as President and Marcelo Danloy as Vice-president of the company.

Be it amended that the corporations officers are hereby changed and shall hereafter be known as Marcelo Danloy as President/Director, Eugenio Mader as Vice-president/Director, and Narcela Bianchini as Scoretary/Treasurer/Director of the company.
