ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

Section 1.1. Name. The name of the corporation is HKH Properties, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Duration

Section 2.1. Duration. This corporation shall exist perpetually.
