This corporation shall indemnify its directors and officers, and may indemnify its employees and agents, to the fullest extent permitted by the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act, as the same may be amended and supplemented, from and against claims, demands, losses, costs, expenses, obligations, liabilities, damages, recoveries and deficiencies, including interest, penalties, and reasonable attorney's fees, including but not limited to those incurred in defending a claim, action, suit, proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, as well as appeals, or other matters referred to in or covered by said provisions, including advancement of expenses prior to the final disposition of such proceedings and amounts paid in settlement of such proceedings; indemnification shall be limited to those actions by the director, officer, employee or agent that the Board of Directors determines to be within Florida Statutes Sections 607.0850(1) and 607.0850(2), as the same may be amended and supplemented; any action determined by the Board to be within Florida Statute 607.0850(7), whether adjudicated by a court of law, arbitration, mediation, plea agreement, settlement or any other form of compromise by the director, officer, employee or agent, shall not be indemnified by the corporation; and the indemnification provided for herein shall not be decined exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any bylaw, agreement, vote of shareholders or disinterested directors or otherwise, both as to action in his or her official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding such office; and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a director, officer, employee or agent; and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors and administrators of such a person; and an adjudication of liability shall not affect the right to indemnification for those indemnified.
