ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NEW BEGINNINGS AGAIN, INC.



The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and form a Corporation for profit, hereby under Chapter 607 of the Florida Statues and certifies that:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME: The name of the Corporation is NEW BEGINNINGS AGAIN, INC., (hereinafter, "Corporation").

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSE OF CORPORATION: This Corporation is organized for the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

7.1 The Director(s) of the Corporation shall be:

7.2 The personal liability of the directors of the Corporation is eliminated to the fullest extent permitted by the provisions and statues of the laws of the State of Florida, as the same may be amended and supplemented.

ARTICLE NINE

INDEMMNIFICATION: The Corporation shall, to the fullest extent permitted by the laws of the State of Florida, as the same may be amended and supplemented, indemnify any and all persons whom it shall have the power to indemnify under said Article from and against any and all of the expenses, liabilities, or other matters referred to in or covered by said Article, and the indemnification provided for herein shall not be deemed

exclusive of any other rights to which any other person, may be entitled under any Bylaw, Resolution of the Shareholders, Resolution of the Directors, agreement, or otherwise, as permitted by said Article, as to action to any capacity in which he served at the request of the Corporation.

ARTICLE TEN

CORPORATE CAPITALIZATION:

- 10.1 The maximum number of shares that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is **ONE THOUSAND** (1000) shares of common stock, each share having the par value of **ONE DOLLAR** (\$1.00).

- 10.3 The Board of Director(s) of the Corporation may authorize the issuance from time to time of shares of its stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, or securities convertible into shares of its stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, for such consideration as the Board of Director(s) may deem advisable, subject to such restrictions or limitations, if any, as may be set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.
- 10.4 The Board of Director(s) of the Corporation may, by Restated Articles of Incorporation, classify or reclassify any unissued stock from time to time by setting or changing the preferences, conversions or other rights, voting powers, restrictions, limitations as to dividends, qualifications, or term or conditions of redemption of the stock.
