ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is KENDALL COMPANY, and has its principal place of business at 121 S. Brown Avenue, Orlando, Florida, 32801.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS AND POWERS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation is to engage in any and all business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and this Corporation shall have all of the corporate powers enumerated in the Florida General Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is 1,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing upon the filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE V. REGISTERED AGENT AND INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

The Registered Agent and the street address of the initial Registered Office of this Corporation in the State of Florida shall be:

The Board of Directors from time to time may move the Registered Office to any other address in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI. PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Each Shareholder of the Corporation shall have the right to purchase, subscribe for, or receive a right or rights to purchase or subscribe for, at the price for which it is offered to others, that Shareholder's pro rata portion of the following:

A. Any stock of any class that the Corporation may issue or sell, whether or not exchangeable for any stock of the Corporation of any class or classes, and whether or not of unissued shares authorized by the Articles of Incorporation as originally filed or by any amendment thereof or out of shares of stock of the Corporation acquired by it after the issuance thereof, and whether issued for cash or other consideration; or,

B. Any obligation that the Corporation may issue or sell which is convertible into or exchangeable for any stock of the Corporation of any class or classes, or to which is attached or pertinent any warrant or warrants or other instruments conferring on the holder the right to subscribe for or purchase from the Corporation any shares of its stock of any class or classes.

This right shall be deemed waived by any Shareholder who does not exercise it and pay for the shares preempted within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice from the Corporation stating the price, terms and conditions of the issue of shares and inviting the Shareholder to exercise this preemptive right. This right may also be waived by a written waiver signed by the Shareholder.

ARTICLE VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There shall be three (3) directors of the corporation; however, such number may be changed as provided in the Bylaws or by law. The initial directors of the corporation shall be elected at the organizational meeting or as further set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII. INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law.


ARTICLE X. INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer or director or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XI. BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend and repeal the Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the Shareholders as provided by law; however, the Shareholders shall not have the power to adopt or amend the Bylaws that fixes a greater quorum or voting requirement for Shareholders than is required by law.

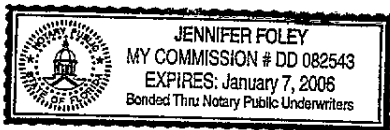




