ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation shall be Levinson & Lopez, P.A.

ARTICLE II

TERM OF CORPORATION

The corporate existence of the Corporation shall continue perpetually.

ARTICLE III

GENERAL PURPOSES

The Corporation has been organized as a "professional corporation" for the rendition of such services regulated by the Board of Architecture and Interior Design of the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation pursuant to Chapter 621 of the Florida Statutes. The Corporation shall indemnify its Directors and officers to the fullest extent permitted by Florida law.

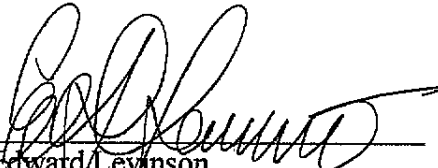

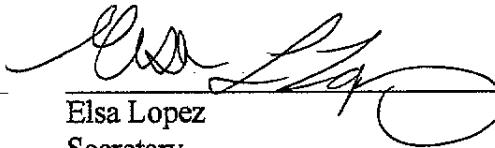
