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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned incorporator hereby forms a corporation under Chapter 607 of the laws of the state of Florida.

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of this Corporation is You Shared.Com, Inc. (the "Corporation").

**ARTICLE II
PURPOSE OF BUSINESS**

The purpose of the Corporation is primarily to sell corporate identity, branding, promotional and to sell, advertising time on streamed, p2p, content owners, and hosted Internet music companies. To sublicense You Shared.com technology to other streamed, p2p, hosted Internet music companies and to deliver commercial ad content to the same.

**ARTICLE III
NATURE OF THE BUSINESS**

The general nature of the business to be transacted by the Corporation is:

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in, and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services, of every class, kind and description.

To conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks, and licenses, in the state of Florida and in all other states and countries.

To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation, and engage in the same or other character of business that is legal in the state of Florida.

To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the state of Florida, or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

**ARTICLE IV
CAPITAL STOCK**

The maximum number of share of stock that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is fifty million (50,000,000) shares of common stock with a

par value of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per share. The shareholders of common stock shall have pre-emptive rights to acquire unissued or treasury share of the corporation.

ARTICLE V PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Each shareholder of the Corporation shall have the first right to purchase shares (and securities convertible into shares) of any class, kind or series of stock in the Corporation that may be, from time to time, issued (whether or not currently authorized), including shares from the treasury of the Corporation, in the ration that the number of shares held by such shareholder at the time of issue bears to the total number of shares outstanding, exclusive of treasury shares.

This right may be deemed as waived by any shareholder who, having received written notice thereof and an invitation to pre-empt, does not exercise such right and pay for the shares pre-empted within thirty days of receipt of such written notice. This right may also be waived by an affirmative written waiver submitted by the shareholder within such thirty-day time frame.

ARTICLE VI CAPITALIZATION

The amount of capital with which the Corporation will begin business is \$5,000.00

ARTICLE VII TERM OF EXISTANCE

The corporation shall exist in perpetuity.

ARTICLE VIII ADDRESS OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE, ADDRESS OF INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND NAME OF REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 14 Colonial Club Drive, #200, Boynton Beach, Florida 33435. The Board of Directors may, from time to time, move the registered office to any other address in Florida. The initial registered agent of the Corporation is Robert O'Kane, whose business address is: 14 Colonial Club Drive, #200 Boynton Beach Florida 33435, and mailing address is: P. O. Box 30355, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida 33420-0335.

ARTICLE IX DIRECTORS

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the corporation managed under the direction of its Board of Directors, subject to any limitations set forth in these Articles of Incorporation. This Corporation shall have a minimum of two (2) Directors, initially. All of the members of the Board of Directors

will be elected by the shareholders at the annual meeting of shareholder with the exception of two members of the Board of Directors who must be appointed by the Board of Directors of The eDepot.com, Inc. The number of directors may be increased to a maximum of 15 directors, and any number greater than two (2) must be an odd number. The number of Directors may be increased or diminished from time to time, by By-Laws adopted by the stockholders.


