ARTICLES OF INCORPÖRATION

A PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION

The undersigned, who is/are duly licensed to practice medicine in the State of Florida, desiring to form a professional corporation in accordance with Florida Professional Service Corporation Act (Chapter 621 Fla. Stat.) and the Florida Business Corporation Act (Chapter 607 Fla. Stat.), hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1 - Name

1.1 The name of the corporation is Patrick F. Skiffington, P.A.

ARTICLE 2 - Purpose and Limitations

- 2.1 The purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be to engage in the **practice of real estate**, and to take all actions that are necessary or proper in connection therewith.
- 2.2 The professional services of the corporation shall be rendered only through its officers, employees and agents who are duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render such services within the State of Florida.
- 2.3 The corporation shall not engage in any business other than rendering the professional services for which it was specifically organized, however, the corporation may invest it funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investments, and may own any real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.
- 2.4 The corporation shall not issue any of its capital stock to anyone other than a professional corporation, professional limited liability company, or an individual who is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same specific professional services as those for which the corporation is incorporated; and no shareholder shall enter

into a voting trust agreement or any other type of agreement vesting another person with the authority to exercise the voting power of any or all of the person's stock.

ARTICLE 3 - Registered Office and Agent

3.1 The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 5431 Brookline Road, Orlando, FL 32819, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation whose business office is identical with such registered office is Patrick F. Skiffington.

ARTICLE 4 - Term of Existence

4.1 The corporation shall commence its corporate existence on the date these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Department of State, and shall have perpetual existence thereafter unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE 5 - Principal Office

5.1 The principal office, and mailing address of the corporation is 5431 Brookline Road, Orlando, FL 32819.

ARTICLE 6 - Capital Stock

- 6.1 The maximum number of shares of stock that the corporation is authorized to issue is 1,000 shares of common stock having par value of ten (\$0.10) cents per share.
- 6.2 The consideration to be paid for each share shall be fixed by a majority of the shareholders.
- 6.3 No shareholder may sell or transfer shares of stock of the corporation to anyone other than a professional corporation, professional limited liability company, or an individual who is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same specific professional services as those for which the corporation is incorporated.

ARTICLE 7 - Incorporator

7.1 The name and street address of the Incorporator of the corporation, who is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same professional services as the corporation, is:

8.1 The business of the corporation shall be managed by the shareholders of the corporation rather than by a Board of Directors. A shareholders agreement eliminating the board of directors and authorizing the exercise of corporate powers by a managing shareholder has been entered into by all of the shareholders at the time the agreement is made known to the corporation.

ARTICLE 9 - Amendment to Articles

9.1 These Articles of incorporation may be amended at any time by the affirmative vote of two thirds of the shareholders of the corporation.


