Article I - Name

The name of this corporation is PRO-AG LANDSCAPING, INC.

Article II - Address

The mailing address of the principal office of this corporation is 11315 Old Bicycle Road, Panama City, Florida 32404.

Article III - Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of the execution and acknowledgment of these Articles.

Article IV - Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business.

Article V - Capital Stock

This corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value common stock.

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

Article VIII - Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 311 Magnolia Avenue, Panama City, Florida 32401 and the name of the initial registered resident agent of this corporation at that address is Douglas B. Dykes.

Article IX - Initial Board of Directors and Officers

This corporation shall have 1 directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the bylaws but shall never be less than one. Article X - Incorporator

Article XI - Bylaws

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

Article XII - Restrictions on Transfer of Stock

Shares of capital stock of this corporation shall be issued to the following persons and in the amounts set opposite their names: LESTER HARRISON 1000 SHARES

Shares held by the initial shareholder listed above may not be resold or otherwise transferred to other persons unless such shares are first offered to the remaining shareholders or to this corporation. The price and terms at which, and the time within which, such shares may be offered and sold shall further be specified by written agreement among all of the shareholders and

Article XIII - Cumulative Voting

this corporation.

At each election for directors, every shareholder entitled to vote at such election shall have the right to cumulate his votes by giving one candidate as many votes as the number of directors to be elected at that time multiplied by the number of his shares, or by distributing such votes on the same principal among any number of such candidates.

Article XIV - Calling of Special Meetings

Special meetings of shareholders may be called by a majority of the outstanding shares.

Article XV - Shareholder Quorum and Voting

Any action of the shareholders of this corporation must be taken at a meeting of shareholders of this corporation duly called as provided by law.

Article XVI - Management of Corporation by Shareholders

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this corporation shall be managed under the direction of, the shareholders of this corporation.

Article XVII - Director Quorum and Voting

A majority of directors shall constitute a quorum for a meeting of directors.

If a quorum is present, the affirmative vote of all of the directors present, or, if a director or directors have abstained from voting because of an interest in the matter to be voted upon, the affirmative vote of all of the remaining directors, shall be the act of the Board of Directors.

Article XVIII - Meeting by Conference Telephone

Members of the Board of Directors may participate in meetings of the Board of Directors by means of conference telephone as provided by law.

Article XIX - Action by Directors Without a Meeting

The directors of this corporation may take action by written consent, as provided by law.

Article XX - Indemnification

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
