ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

IN-DEPTH INVESTIGATIONS, INC.

The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act and providing for the formation, rights, and privileges of corporations for profit, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation;

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be **IN-DEPTH INVESTIGATIONS, INC.**, and its principal place of business shall be in the county of Okaloosa, Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such places as may be designated by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The period of duration for this Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purpose of the Corporation is to provide investigation services, service of process, insurance adjusting services, consulting services and multi-media services, and to do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein set forth and for any other legal purpose.

The corporation shall have authority to issue ten thousand (10,000) shares of common stock, all of one class, one dollar (\$1.00) par value per share.

The corporation is authorized to issue only one class of stock, and all issued stock shall be held of record by not more than seventy-five (75) persons. Stock shall be issued and transferable only to natural persons who are not nonresident aliens.

ARTICLE V - PRINCIPAL OFFICE




