Articles of Incorporation

In compliance with Chapter 607 and 621 of the Florida Statutes:



Article I

The name of the corporation shall be WWFF Web Designs, Inc.

Article II

The principal place of business and its mailing address is 2563 Stony Brook Lane, Clearwater, Florida, 33761.

Article III

WWFF Web Designs, Inc. is organized for the purpose of developing and hosting web sites on the World Wide Web as well as for any other lawful business purpose allowed under the rules, regulations, and statutes of the State of Florida.
