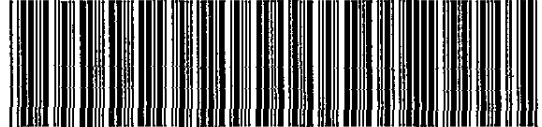

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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT FOR


Contractor Building Services, Inc.
