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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NICOLE K. LUBELL, P.A.



I. the undersigned, for the purpose of becoming a Professional Association under the Laws of Florida, by and under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges, and immunities of Professional Associations, file these Articles of Incoporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Professional Association is NICOLE K. LUBELL, P.A.

ARTICLE II

The nature of the Professional Association's business to be transacted is:

To engage in and and carry on the practice of law in the State of Florida. To do any and all things permitted by a licensed attorney in the State of Florida and by a Member of the Florida Bar.

To engage in and carry on any business or businesses and every act or deed pertaining thereto, either directly or indirectly, which is not prohibited by the Laws of the State of Florida, and to so engage in and carry on said business or businesses in Florida, or in any other State in the United States or in any foreign country. To do any and all things necessary, suitable, useful, proper or admissible for the accomplishment of any one of the purposes or for the attainment of any of the objects or further exercise of the powers herein set forth, whether herein specified or not, either alone or in connection with other firms, individuals, corporations or Professional Associations, either in this State or throughout the United States and elsewhere.

ARTICLE III

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers, but no recitation, expression or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be exclusive, but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

ARTICLE IV

Any unissued stock or such additional authorized issue of new stock or of other securities convertible into stock may be issued and disposed of pursuant to resolution of the Board of Directors to such persons, firms, Professional Associations or associations and upon such terms as may be deemed advisable by the Board of Directors in the exercise of their discretion.

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ARTICLE V

The maximum number of shares of stock of this Professional Association is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be 500 shares of One (\$1.00) Dollar par value, unless duly changed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

<u>ARTICLE VI</u>

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this Professional Association of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro-rate share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

Initially, all shares shall be owned by NICOLE K. LUBELL. Only licensed attorneys and members of the Florida Bar shall be entitled to purchase shares of stock from the Professional Association or any of its shareholders.

ARTICLE VII

principal

The street address of the initial registered office of this Professional Association in the State of Florida shall be 18250 N.W. SECOND AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA 33169, which is the principal place of the Professional Association; and the name of the initial registered agent of this Professional Association at that address is Steven L. Lubell, Esq.

The Professional Association may have such other places of business, both within and without the State of Florida, and in foreign countries, as may be necessary and convenient.

ARTICLE VIII

This Professional Association shall exist perpetually beginning May 1, 2002.

ARTICLE IX

This Professional Association shall have One director initially: Nicole K. Lubell. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time in accordance with the By-laws adopted by the stockholders, but shall never be less than one.
